TELL THEM:

- All but proven, emergency Herd Management Area (HMA) roundups must be stopped immediately.
- A full Federal investigation of the BLM's Wild Horse and Burro Program must be held before any further roundups will be allowed to occur.
- In addition, The National Academy of Sciences must be allowed to review the BLM's protocol before any removal of Wild Horses and Burros from HMAs will be allowed to occur.
